# ANTI- RAGGING COMMITTEE

Under the direction of UGC guidelines and HEI, KSA, Barns college of Arts, Science and commerce strictly banded for regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009," Any student found guilty of ragging, will be severely dealt with, in accordance with the Provisions of the Law. These regulations are followed by our college strictly.

#### ANTI RAGGING

Ragging is a criminal offense. Ragging is strictly prohibited by both State Govt. and Central Govt. Punishment for ragging will be as follows:

- (i) Imprisonment up to three years and fine of Rs.50,000/-
- (ii) Dismissal from the college

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises and outside. Students indulging in ragging will be punished as per "The Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 (Mah. XXXIII of 1999) Published in Maharashtra Govt. Gazette on 15th May 1999". Such students will also be expelled from the college and F.I.R will be lodged with the police against them. Moreover, it will be mentioned in the college leaving certificate of such students that they are expelled because of their indulgence

Students with a previous record of ragging will not be admitted to this College.

### Objectives:

- To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student.
- To monitor, direct and oversee the functions and performance of the Anti-Ragging Squads in prevention and curbing of ragging in the institution.



## Responsibility

- To carry out awareness programmes like workshops, seminars etc for students to know about the consequences of ragging.
- To address any ragging issues immediately and take action as advised by the committee.
- To make adequate publicity on anti-ragging through various notices and stickers
- To be vigilant at all hours all around the campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
- To ensure ragging free campus.
- To mention of anti-ragging warming in the College prospectus and Web site
