# Scheme of Examination Under Credit Based Evaluation System

## **A) Traditional Programs**

### I. Scheme of Examination

The performance of the learners shall be evaluated at the end of each semester by conducting semester end exams with 100 marks for each course.

Semester End Examination- 100% (100 Marks)

- i) Duration These examination shall be of 3 hours duration
- ii) All questions shall be compulsory with internal choice within the question

## II. Standard of Passing:

The learner to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in each course in the end semester exam.

There will be an internal assessment for course Foundation Course in each semester for 25 marks and End semester with 75 marks.

# **B. Professional Programs**

### I. Scheme of Examination

The performance of the learners shall be evaluated into two components viz., by internal Assessment carrying of 25% marks and by conducting Semester –wise End Examination carrying 75% marks. The allocation of marks for the Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination is as follows:-

#### A) Internal Assessment-25% (25 marks)

### For Courses without practical

#### **B) Semester End Examination –**

Professional: 75% (75 Marks)

- i) Duration These examination shall be of 2.5 hours duration.
- ii) All questions shall be compulsory with internal choice within the question.
- iii) Questions may be sub divided into sub question a,b,c.... and allocation of marks depends on the weightage of the topics.

## II) Standard of Passing

#### Traditional:

The learner to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate for each course.

#### Professional:

The learner to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate for each course where the course consists of Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination. The learner shall obtain a minimum of 40% of marks (i.e. 10 out 25) in the Internal Assessment and 40% marks in the semester end examination (i.e. 30 out 75) separately, to pass the course and minimum of grade D to pass a particular semester. A learner will be said to have passed the course if the learner passed the internal assessment and semester end examination separately.
